Criteria	Team Augmentation	Fully Outsourced Product Development
<b>Team composition and allocation</b>	100% dedicated resources of the requested profile (composition of the team is defined by the customer)	Project team with all required skills to manage the project throughout development lifecycle (PM, BA, Developer, Architect, DBA, Testers, QA) Some members can be part-time depending on stage and size of project.
<b>Project task allocation</b>	Responsibility of the customer (day to day coordination and supervision)	Scio takes responsibility for coordinating and supervising the work of the team
<b>When to use</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>When customer has the internal resources and time to manage the remote team</li> <li>When the customer wants to retain control of task allocation</li> <li>For ongoing maintenance and issue resolution</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Expertise required is not available in house</li> <li>Internal resources are tied up</li> <li>Delegate responsibility for delivery</li> <li>Speed to market is an issue</li> </ul>
<b>Pricing Models</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Flat fee per month per resource</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Time and materials</li> <li>Flat fee per team per month</li> <li>Fixed bid</li> </ul>
<b>Contract Term</b>	Predefined duration, renewable	Based on project duration, extendable
